

Wash-Water Recycling



Shortly after the construction of Coyote Run's maintenance facility, a wash-water recycling system was purchased and installed to bring the golf course into compliance with federal waste-water discharge laws. The self contained system recycles the water used for washing equipment and any gas or diesel fuel spilled during the fueling of golf course equipment. The recycling system separates grass clippings from the wash water and then uses microbes to render hydro-carbons, pesticides and other contaminants harmless. The decontaminated water is stored in a large stainless steel tank until it is needed to wash another piece of equipment, saving thousands of gallons of potable water every year.
